Ongoing Research Projects

The Indigenous Planetary Health Film Lab (2019 to present)

This ongoing research project curates documentary projects from around the world made by Indigenous youth. In partnership with local universities, Indigenous youth are trained in UN filmmaking techniques using new digital media tools. The films they produce tell stories of planetary health issues in their communities showcasing their unique Traditional Ecological Knowledge (TEK) and preserving this cultural knowledge and language for global knowledge mobilization and future generations. The Film Lab has worked with more than 40 Indigenous communities in the Circumpolar Arctic (Canada, Alaska, Norway, Iceland), Ecuador, Australia, Colombia, Jamaica, Ghana, Costa Rica, and Belize.

The Ghana Indigenous Youth Videography Programme (2021 to present)

This ongoing research project out of Wilfrid Laurier University in Waterloo, Canada is partnered with the Ghana Institute of Management and Public Administration (GIMPA) University in Accra, Ghana. Each year, we train Indigenous youth from Ghana to tell climate stories throughout the country focusing their lenses on the challenges and the adaptation methods resulting from climate impacts in urban and agricultural areas.

This unique form of UN engagement for youth is comprised of a GIS map where youth-made video projects are geo-located as a resource for UN policymakers. This digital preservation and curation project now has more than 1,200 entries from youth in more than 160 countries. In 2023, it won the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals Action Award.
